



Lynca Meats source industry leading pigs from our loyal supplier base. The sourcing of these pigs go through the following processes which we believe substantiate that they effectively have been through a “Premium Selection” process:

- Each farmer that supplies New Style Pork is required to fill out a supplier questionnaire to ascertain if the farm meets our internal requirements
- An in-house qualified Veterinarian is an Executive Director of Lynca / New Style Pork. He has responsibility to ensure that only the very best pigs are procured. The Veterinarian is acknowledged to be an industry leader in this regard and regularly visits our farmers to ensure that the farms and their pigs meet our stringent internal and external standards
- Our pigs are independently classified and inspected by IMQAS. Pigs / cuts not meeting predetermined standards (by law) are condemned
- We believe we differentiate ourselves in the market by placing focus on selecting premium pigs in the market. As such we have the following pre-determined selection criteria for our pigs:
 - We have an independent on site vet who has independent responsibility to ensure that only the best quality pigs are allowed to be slaughtered
 - We only use pigs with Topigs or PIC genetics
 - All our pork is fully traceable from plate to farm
 - Our pigs are export approved and are accredited as being “compartmentalized” (these farms need to be audited and approved as such)
 - We are driving that all our farmers are Pork 360 approved.
 - Our pigs are ethically raised (in fact the vast majority of our pigs are accredited / in the process of being defined as being “Sow Stall Friendly” in terms of a PnP specification that is accredited directly by SAMIC)
 - We measure and manage our pork to ensure that it is free from PSE
 - Our pigs do not contain traces of Anti-Biotics and Hormones.
 - Our facility is HACCP, Woolworths, Export, PRRS and FSA accredited which attests to aspects of the above and attests to our rigorous quality standards. We are aiming to be ISO22000 accredited by next year.
 - Our facility is accredited by and is regularly visited by SPCA. Our facility is acknowledged and accredited as treating our pigs ethically according to SPCA animal welfare standards.
