2025 SAMIC Month report

June

Executive summary

During June, SAMIC performed over 600 inspections on farms, abattoirs, deboning plants, meat traders including livestock (BLNS) inspections, carcasses and primal meat products. We are finding and addressing all deviations as they happen. A summary of these as follows:

- Abattoir deviations at 20.4% for June.
- Meat traders show 2.3% deviations.
- Export stores have 4% non-compliant, that were addressed.
- QI/GI have non-compliances below 1%.
- A total of 17 Classifier Refreshers were conducted.

In June we kicked off the preparations for the much-anticipated SAMIC national carcass competition finale and prize giving. Competitions are ongoing and in June marking the official cut off for the 2025 evaluations, there were 17 competitions that were conducted over the various species. A total of 50 competition events have made up the annual cumulative competitions over the country thus far, evaluating all four species under categories of Commercial and Emerging Farmers. The nature of the carcass competition has always been to communicate and impart the Classification system and its criteria to farmers and other producers. In the future, as we add to and evolve the carcass Classification system this will also form part of the competition. Additionally, as noted last month, we are tracking well with the additional criteria that will bring in a Sustainability and a Commercial element into the competition.

Several auctions were closed in June due to the FMD crisis. We will proceed with absolute care and biosafety as we plan next month's auctions. 10 auctions are scheduled for July.

This month, all SAMIC auditors were equipped with a biosecurity kit, including sanitiser, spray bottle and enough overalls to avoid the same protective wear being used from one abattoir to the next. We have issued our inspectors with this, together with a newly reviewed SAMIC Biosecurity Protocol, to ensure that all SAMIC functions can be performed with utmost biosecurity, avoiding any cross contamination in the performance of our duties.

SAMIC's digitalisation progress is progressing well. We are now tracking on 17% progress completion on the overall project which is tracking at 18% on the timeline (46 of the 56 weeks are remaining to completion) – this is on track and on time. We already have a "Clickable Prototype" development version for the audits and audit builder. We are busy testing and evaluating the prototype with our stakeholders, to ensure we give the expected reporting, with the required accuracy and "on time". We call this platform "iSAMIC Mobile" and are expecting many great things from this application.

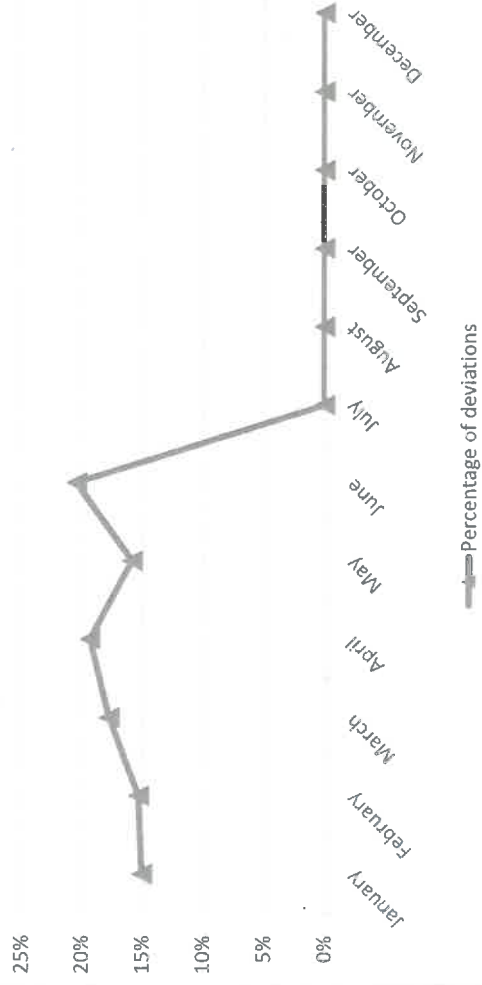

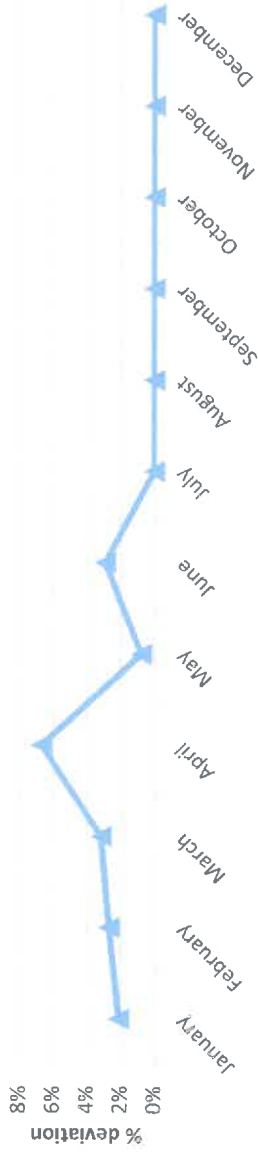

 - 25 Abattoir stores were audited for export purposes.
 - 1 Abattoir store was non-compliant.
10. Visits for slaughter figures
 - 483 Visits on Beef for the year.
 - 443 Visits on Sheep for the year.
 - 365 Visits on Pork for the year.
11. Withdrawal of abattoir identification codes
 - No Abattoir's code to classify was withdrawn this month by SAMIC on behalf of the National Department of Agriculture due to the non compliance with the Standing Regulations. 1 Abattoir code was temporarily withdrawn.
12. Warnings to Abattoirs
 - 5 Abattoirs received warnings from SAMIC on behalf of the Department of Agriculture's Directorate of Food Safety and Quality Assurance for lesser transgressiones of the Standing Regulations.
 - No Abattoir received a final warning from SAMIC on behalf of the Department of Agriculture's Directorate of Food Safety and Quality Assurance for lesser transgressiones of the Standing Regulations.
13. Registration / Re-registration of Abattoirs
 - 1 previously non-classifying abattoirs were registered for the month to classify and no abattoir was re-registered to classify.
14. Trade Transgressions
 - 4 Meat traders received a warning from SAMIC on behalf of the Department of Agriculture's Directorate of Food Safety and Quality Assurance for transgression of the Standing Regulations.
15. Auctions
 - No Auctions were audited for compliance.
16. BLNS
 - 45 BLNS audits were done for the month.
17. During June 2025 written warnings were issued for no correlation numbers on heads of beef and sheep. A written warning was also issued for carcasses not roller marked before the cold room. SAPPO Pork carcass competitions were held at various abattoirs throughout South Africa.

- To promote pork among South African consumers.
- To promote carcass quality of South African pork through expert feedback to producers.
- To encourage the production of high-quality meat in regarding the market needs.
- To demonstrate the classification system and the advantages thereof to producers.
